KEY WORDS: RNA biology, neurobiology, molecular biology, lab manager

Scope of research: Non-coding RNA and the gene expression regulation in the brain and neurons.

Position will be carried out within the frames of a NAWA Polish Returns 2019 project, entitled "*Deciphering networks of regulatory RNAs in the central nervous system*", financed by the National Academic Exchange Agency; Principal Investigator: Monika Piwecka, PhD.

I. Responsibilities:

- 1. Maintenance of a working space in the lab.
- 2. Requesting price quotations and ordering reagents, materials and equipment necessary to complete the project.
- 3. Cataloging and maintenance of samples of biological material.
- 4. Assisting in conducting research projects in terms of establishing, cataloging and modifying protocols; assisting team members with preparation of buffers, materials and reagents; conducting standard experimental procedures (e. g. genotyping, RNA *in situ* hybridization, qRT-PCR, Western Blot, Northern Blot, molecular cloning, cell culture maintenance, protein and nucleic acid isolation).

II. Required qualifications:

- 1. Master of Science in molecular biology, biotechnology, or related field.
- 2. Minimum 4 years of laboratory work experience with molecular biology, biochemistry, and/or cell culture. Prior experience with microscopy and/or primary cell culture would be an additional asset.
- 3. Enthusiasm about experimental work.
- 4. Excellent organizational skills.
- 5. Very good command of spoken and written English.

III. Required documents:

- 1. Candidate's professional experience with regard to molecular and cellular biology techniques, basic and applied research participance, mobility, documented scientific achievements.
- 2. Knowledge of project.
- 3. During the recruitment procedure, selected candidates may be invited to an interview.
- VII. During the recruitment procedure selected candidates may be invited to an interview. The recruitment procedure shall be concluded until November 17th, 2021.

VIII. Employment shall take place in compliance with the provisions of the Labor Code of Poland.

IX. Hereby offered is a replacement position. A fixed-term contract with 3 months of trial period, with possibility of extending up to 12 months in total, is offered. Monthly remuneration is **6 150,00** PLN (total employer cost).

Information clause:

Pursuant to the stipulations of the regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), further referred to as GDPR, we hereby inform that:

• The legal basis for processing personal data is the Act of 26 June 1974 – The Labor Code, Act of 30 April 2010 on the Polish Academy of Sciences or the consent of the person whose data shall be subjected to processing.
