The Institute of Bioorganic Chemistry, PAS, in Poznan is an interdisciplinary research center, unique across Europe and worldwide, orchestrating the areas of chemistry, biology and informatics. It encompasses modern laboratory space with very well equipped specialized laboratories, supporting the conducted studies. Research at IBCH PAS is primarily focused around synthesis and studies of the structure and function of nucleic acids and proteins, as well as their components. The Institute is also open to other interdisciplinary fields of study, combining chemistry, biology and informatics in various configurations.

IBCH PAS is currently planning to establish a new department, operating within the field of **molecular bioimaging by mass spectrometry**

The offer is addressed to ambitious scientists who would like to carry out their independent scientific studies at IBCH PAS in a long-term perspective. The candidate should formulate his/her own, interesting topic of scientific activity, falling within the area of molecular bioimaging with the use of mass spectrometry. It is required that research is carried out at a high level of science (on an international scale). The results shall be published in renowned, international journals. It is also expected that the newly appointed Head of the Department will successfully apply for grants, enabling implementation of research projects, and actively take part in initiatives for the local and international scientific community.

For scientific departments, IBCH PAS ensures laboratory space and general equipment, and support of a number of facilities in various areas of research (see https://portal.ibch.poznan.pl/specialized-laboratories/).







I. Requirements for the Candidates:

- 1. At least a PhD degree in chemistry, biology, or related sciences.
- 2. Excellent track record in chemistry, biology, or related sciences, documented by scientific publications.
- 3. Experience in acquiring funds for research.
- 4. Excellent command of spoken and written English.
- 5. Experience in management of research groups, as well as completion of long-term research internships shall be considered as additional assets.

II. Required documents:

- 1. Letter of application addressed to the Director of IBCH PAS.
- 2. Curriculum vitae, including:
- 1) ORCID identifier (and other, e.g., Web of Science Researcher ID, Scopus Author Identifier, etc.);
- 2) the course of education;
- 3) professional career (places of employment and positions, research internships, manager functions);
- 4) most significant scientific achievements;
- 5) a list of reviewed scientific publications <u>only those indexed in the Web of Science</u> database:
 - o indicate yourself (bold), additionally as the first (underline) or corresponding author (asterisk),
 - \circ it is recommended to provide DOI for the papers,
 - o include journal's Impact Factor according to Journal Citation Reports,
 - o specify the total number of citations in the Web of Science (without self-citations),
 - $\circ\,$ specify the Hirsch index (according to the Web of Science);
- 6) other publications;
- 7) a list of inventions, patents, implementation reports;
- 8) teaching achievements
- 9) organizational achievements
- 10) management of research projects (PI positions) indicate financing institutions, budgets and duration);
- 11) significant participation in large research projects (please specify your role, financing institutions, budgets and duration);
- 12) list of awards and distinctions;
- 13) other relevant information.

It is obligatory to include all of the above points in your CV in the same order. If there are no achievements in any area, write "none".

- 3. Research program and a short description of the department's operational concept (up to four pages A4 format). This should encompass ambitious and realistic plans, in line with the IBCH PAS mission, where the actions resulting in achieving significant research results will be described in a convincing way. Only applications that will ensure a long-term operation of the department will be accepted.
- 4. Scan of the PhD or professorship diploma or certificate.

IV. The submission deadline is February 28th, 2022.

V. In the course of the recruitment procedure, selected candidates may be asked to deliver a public or non-public presentation of their research achievements, and an operational concept for the department proposal.

VI. The recruitment committee shall formulate relevant recommendation for the Scientific Board of IBCH PAS no later than on April 30th, 2022.

VII. This recruitment procedure for the position of a head of department is simultaneously a recruitment for employment as a scientist in IBCH PAS. The successful candidate shall be employed as an Assistant Professor, Associate Professor or Professor, depending on his/her degree/scientific title. Employment will take place in accordance with the provisions of the Labor Code of Poland and HR Excellence in Science, while the exact conditions shall be agreed with the selected candidate through negotiations.

VIII. In the case of winning this competition, it is required that the Institute of Bioorganic Chemistry, PAS be the main, full-time place of employment for the head of department.

Information clause:

Pursuant to the stipulations of the regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), further referred to as GDPR, we hereby inform that:

- The personal data of the candidates is processed for the purposes of fulfilling the tasks of the administrator, associated with conducting the recruitment procedure for a vacant position.
- The legal basis for processing personal data is the Act of 26 June 1974 The Labor Code, Act of 30 April 2010 on the Polish Academy of Sciences or the consent of the person whose data shall be subjected to processing.
- Your personal data shall be subjected to processing for period of 3 months upon the date of decision of the recruitment committee. Following this period, the data will be irretrievably and effectively destroyed.
- The personal data of the candidates shall not be transferred to any third country.
- The person whose data shall be subjected to processing has the right to:
